The 2005 Seattle Street of Dreams show site was sizzling hot as 7 top builders

scooped up all 8 show lots in record time. "We've never been out of the starting gate this early.", stated John



Heller, organizer of the event. "These premier builders are proof positive that the Street of Dreams is the premier show to be involved with. Two of the Street homes are already pre-sold, which lends even more credibility to our event. We now have a waiting list of builders that want to get in."


