


What's New In Home Entertainment Systems?



Home entertainment systems have come a long way since you ooh'ed and ahh'ed because your neighbor had a few pairs of speakers that actually fit flush into his walls. Systems have evolved to include wall-mounted screens that allow simple access to your music and other house functions. A talented programmer can make these systems function with true "one touch" simplicity, as if
