Enhance Your Winter Lifestyle With An Indoor Herb Garden!

That frosty chill in the air doesn't mean that you have to wait until spring to delight in the joys of gardening. You can bring the green inside with an indoor herb garden. Indoor herb gardens are great way to keep your winter green and fruitful, not to mention tasty. Making an indoor herb garden is easy, and it's fun!



First, select your herbs. Whether you choose to plant medicinal herbs, aromatic herbs or flavorful herbs your garden will surly enhance your winter lifestyle. If you enjoy a nice cup of hot tea, you could plant your favorite herbal tea plants such as peppermint, chamomile, lemon balm, wild strawberry and golden lemon thyme. If you enjoy creating flavorful meals, you might want to plant herbs such as rosemary, basil, oregano or parsley. If you delight in aromatic oils, soaps, and linen sprays, try aromatic herbs such as lavender, mint, marjoram, and lovage. As you might imagine, your herb garden can be a fun way to express yourself.

After your herbs have been selected, you can now start to build your herb garden. You'll want to choose a container with good drainage. To increase drainage, put wood chips or gravel at the bottom of your container. Get creative with the container you choose!

Once your herb garden is planted, situate your garden in the light of a south or west facing window or keep your garden in a common room where the lights are often on. Follow feeding and watering instruction on your seed packet or plant insert. Once your herbs are grown, remember to use them! Your pruning will stimulate growth.

All About Built Green



WHAT IS BUILT GREEN? Built Green is an environmental building program of the Master Builder Association of King & Snohomish Counties, developed in partnership with King County, Snohomish County and other government agencies in Washington State. Built Green is designed to help homebuyers find quality, affordable homes that offer opportunities to protect the health of their families and the Northwest environment. Interested in learning more about "green homes"? The program provides consumers with four easy-to-understand rating

systems, which quantify environmentally friendly building practices for remodeling and new home construction.

WHO IS BUILT GREEN? Built Green is a network of architects, builders, developers, subcontractors, suppliers, lenders, and real estate agents working together to improve quality of life in King & Snohomish Counties. The Built Green program accomplishes this by using a menu of options that provide quality homes which, compared to standard homes, are more cost-effective to own and operate, healthier, safer, and more protective of our beautiful Pacific Northwest environment.

HOW DOES BUILT GREEN WORK? Building projects are qualified using a "Built Green Checklist" organized into six categories of environmentally friendly action items. There are four of King and Snohomish Counties separate checklists for four different types of projects: homebuilder, remodeler, multifamily, and community. Builders choose and use one of the checklists prior to construction to determine which features to include in the home and to track progress. When construction is complete, the builder send a signed copy of the checklist to the MBA, certifying that the home identified in the project enrollment form contains the identified features. Based upon the certification, and after reviewing the application, the MBA will award the appropriate Certificate of Merit indicating
